Keep a well organised folder with dividers	Provide students with advice on organising and recording learning
Take an active role in group work, class Q&A and discussion	Make effective use of available technology (E.g. data projector, interactive whiteboard)
Know how to improve their performance	Negotiate 'brain breaks' in blocked lessons
Spend sufficient time on private study (independent learning)	Offer students guidance on private study (independent learning)
Discuss work with other students beyond the lesson	Provide students with 'the bigger picture' and share half termly planning sheets
Seek support, advice and guidance where necessary	Discuss indicative, working and target grades with students on a regular basis through one-to-one discussions
