

What is a "walking talking" mock?

<u>Aim</u>

• To build students' confidence and understanding of exam technique

- Help them understand the focus of the question what is asking them to do
- Suggest planning and writing strategies
- Sometimes show model examples
- Help them rehearse appropriate timings
